

## Private Fostering

Are you looking after a child that isn't yours?

Do they live with you.. and is the arrangement going to last for more than 28 days?

The child is under the age of 16 (under 18 if disabled)

If Yes, then this is

Private Fostering and you need to let us know straightaway

You could be looking after someone else's child because the child...

- Is living with the family of a boyfriend or girlfriend;
- Is staying with another family because their parents have separated or divorced;
- Has had an argument at home;
- Is sent to this country, for education or healthcare by parents who live overseas;
- Is living with a friend's family because their parent's (or parents) study or work involves long or unsociable hours;
- Is at boarding school and staying during the holidays;
- Is on a language or holiday exchange.
