Friday, 9 December 2022 – Repeat of Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3 Christmas Nativity in the Main Hall 9:30am.

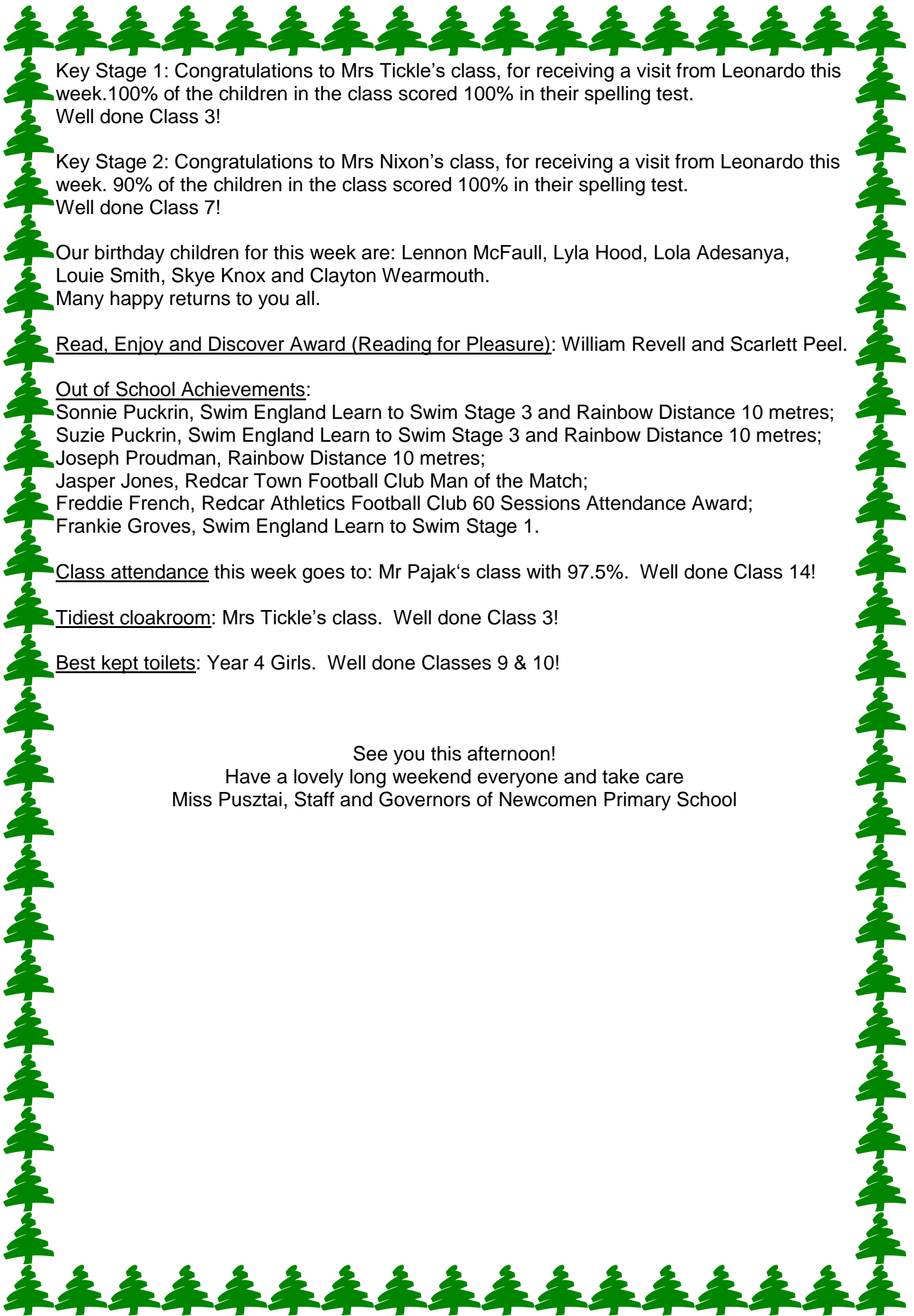
Due to timetabling for the use of the main hall for our Christmas Performances, we are moving our **Christmas Lunch to Friday 9 December 2022**.
