Y6 Home Study Essentials

1. Maths Facts Book

This is added to on a daily basis and forms the bedrock of maths learning. Children need to take this home **<u>each day</u>** to read through; this will really help consolidate maths understanding.

2. English Knowledge Book

This is added to on a regular basis and helps children with their English understanding. Children should read through this on a regular basis at home so the knowledge is committed to their long term memory.

(New vocabulary to be learnt is at the back of the book.)

3. Reading

The government recommends all primary school children read at home on a daily basis to promote fluency and expression. Children, who lack fluency, are not practising their reading aloud often enough. We really appreciate you spending time listening to your children at home. Children, who struggle with reading, struggle to access the rest of the curriculum.

4. Spellings

Spelling lessons take place on a Friday and are revisited during the week with a spelling test taking place the following Friday. Children should spend time at home consciously taking time to commit the spelling rule into their long-term memory with regular practice.

5. Grammar

Grammar homework goes out on a Friday to be returned to school for Tuesday. This is a revision of learning learnt during the week and reinforces the children's understanding.
