Our birthday children for this week are: Annie Brown, Mariia Kuzhel, Violet Fisher and Phoebe Morris.

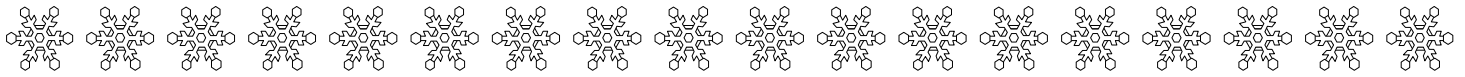
